4th Open Forum: 'Global Economics: History is Not the Past'

All researchers working in the UK are invited to participate in the video competition to win a £100 prize. We are looking for videos presenting concepts and research related to the topic of 'Global Economics: History is Not the Past':

- How historical insights shape today's economic strategies.
- The socio-political challenges that we face and innovative approaches to deal with them.
- The transformative power of interdisciplinary thinking to foster trust in science.

All videos (or a selection of videos in case of over subscription) will be displayed at the venue in Cardiff University. At the event, there will be native speakers of several EU languages (at least Spanish, French, Italian, Dutch, Portuguese, and Polish) who will be able to explain complex scientific topics to the audience in their own language and using lay terms, if necessary. At the end of each event, all the material will be uploaded to our website and shared on social media.

We particularly welcome two types of videos, viz. 1) videos presenting a participant's own research and 2) topic explainers. If you present a poster on your own research, please include a section explaining your research and why it matters in lay terms. In both cases, how accessible the information on your poster is to a general audience is the main criterion in judging the posters for the poster prize. Videos in languages other than English are welcome, provided they include English subtitles.
